Pre-procedure diagnosis: Compression syndromes

Post-procedure diagnosis: Right greater than left thoracic outlet compressions, left renal vein retroarotic compression, mild left CIV compression, no jugular compression in the neck portion

Description of procedure: Venogram bilateral UE, bilateral jugular and left renal and left iliac veins with IVUS and some pressure measurements

Findings: Markedly enlarged veins - likely due to extreme athlete without elevated right heart pressures. Slow flow. Left iliac at stenosis measures 14 mm which is normal in most people and unlikely to be contributing to symptoms beyond the POTS. Left retro aortic renal vein is 75% narrowed with collaterals. IJs large and widely patent from jaw down. Left subclavian with 55% stenosis in neutral and much higher in abducted and overhead position (see dictation). Right subclavian with severe stenosis in all three positions by venography with minimal antegrade flow with the arm over the head and collaterals to EJ. Could not pass the IVUS catheter.

Anesthesia: Moderate Conscious Sedation
